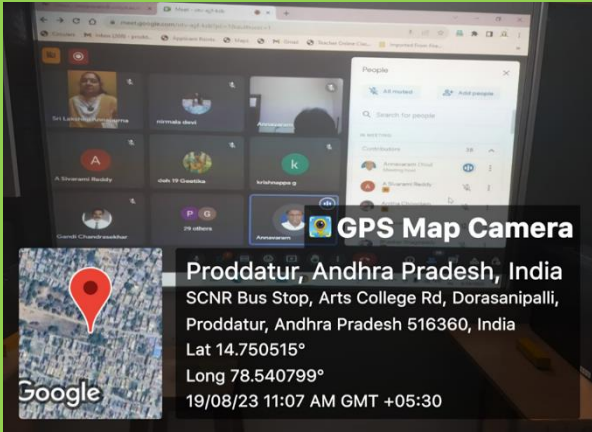

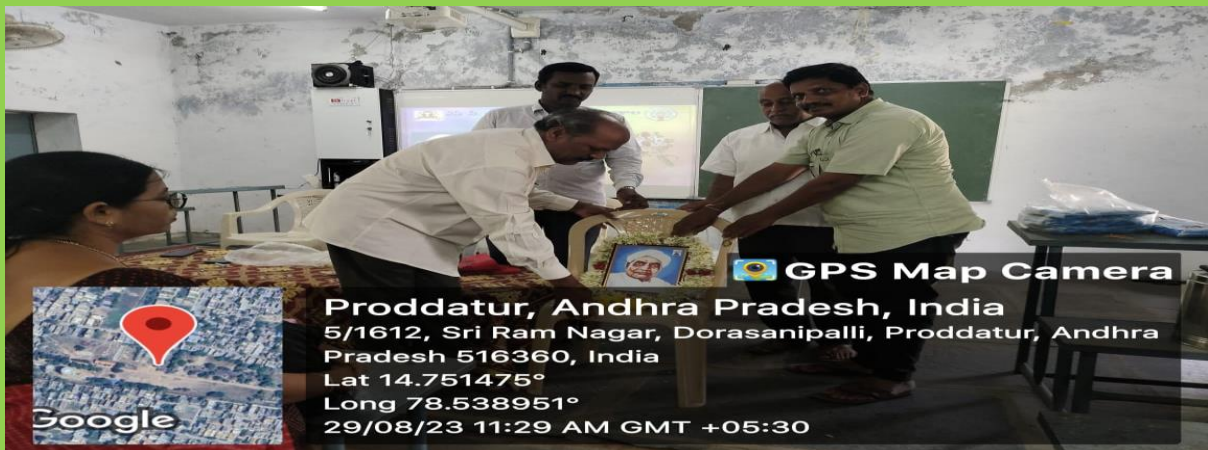

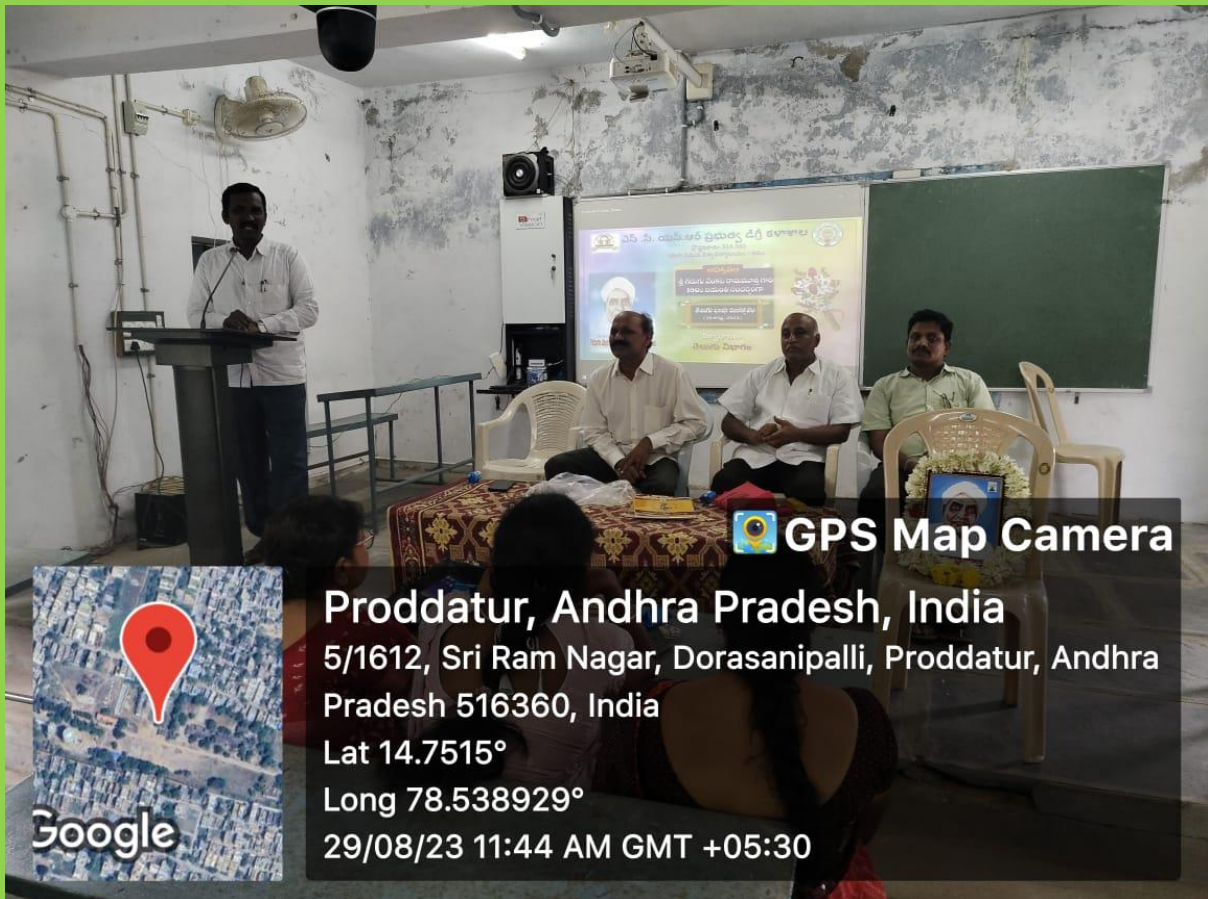


Conclusion:
